NEW ALTERED COPYRIGHT CONDITIONS 1970

The first copyright conditions were published in 1949 in the first edition of Semantography. The experiences in the following 16 years forced me to alter them and I did so in the second edition of "Semantography-Blissymbolics" in 1965 (see S.S.No. 241). Following unhappy publications about my work by some newspaper hacks I altered the conditions again in my last book "The Invention and Discovery that will change our Lives" in 1970 and I reprint these from the page 413 of this book.

NEW COPYRIGHT CONDITIONS

THE BLISSYMBOLS ARE COPYRIGHTED

in order to avoid a new Babel of Symbols.

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1. Mention my name and my book (name, publisher, address, pages, price.)
2. If you show some of my symbols and combinations, please explain the elements and how they combine, as this is shown in the pages 383-391 with the words underneath.

Some journalists and competitors have been unfair in bewildering the readers by showing some of my combinations without any explanations as to the symbol elements. Some went even so far as to ridicule them as "Bliss' squiggles and doodles", etc. (London Sunday Mirror, New York Wall Street Journal, and other publications.)

3. My symbols should not be re-drawn, but photographically copied, because they are designed to fit the keys of a typewriter.

New Development: Mr. A.F. Ure has resigned the trusteeship, and therefore the present trustees are Mr. C.K. Bliss, and Dr. D.N. Everingham only. Proceedings are under way to assign the copyrights at a later date to the ~~National~~ National Library of Australia in Canberra A.C.T.
