

This is Paper No. 27 which is an introduction to the attached BEST Symbol Table which carries the words underneath the symbols.

My dear Friends and Participants of the Correspondence Course on Blissymbolics

I do hope you are all well and so are the Members of your Family. I also hope that you have made good use of the first sheet of the BEST Symbol Table which carries no words underneath the symbols. I have drawn up these sheets in 1973 (six years ago, see the dedication in the left upper corner of the Table, and the Copyright date at the right). I have drawn up these sheets in co-operation with my good friend and Co-worker Dr. Douglas N. Everingham who is a Member of the Federal Parliament Of Australia. With the first Sheet of the BEST table you have also received another set of Questions which I posted to you before setting out for Canada at the end of April 1979.

I do hope that you have already answered my questions and have posted the answers to my Assistant Mrs. Margaret Teale with addless all the correspondence with you. Now please study the second sheet of the Totable which you are receiving with this letter. But again follow my instructions how to beach yourself, examine yourself and correct your mistakes. The trouble is that I am nearly 6 months of the year in Canada and therefore you must study my book and must use my exercise book for studying and examining yourself, etc.etc. In the present case follow this procedure. Take to hand Sheet 1 (without the words underneath the symbols). To not go line by line, but just take one symbol somewhere of which you believe you know the corresponding word to it. Then write it under neath the symbol AND ONLY THEN TAKE TO HAND SHEET 2 and SEE WHETHER YOU HAVE GUESSED CORRECTLY THE WORD. IF YOU HAVE DONE SO, CHAIK UP A VICTORY FOR YOU AND LOOK FOR ANOTHER SYMBOL, WRITE THE WORD DOWN AND CHECK IT. You will learn a lot this way.

Meanwhile I am working on another set of Questions which I hope to be able to send you from Toronto. And if all goes well I shall return to Sydney on the 8th July 1979 Meanwhile kindest regards to all of you and your Families and Friends from Yours
